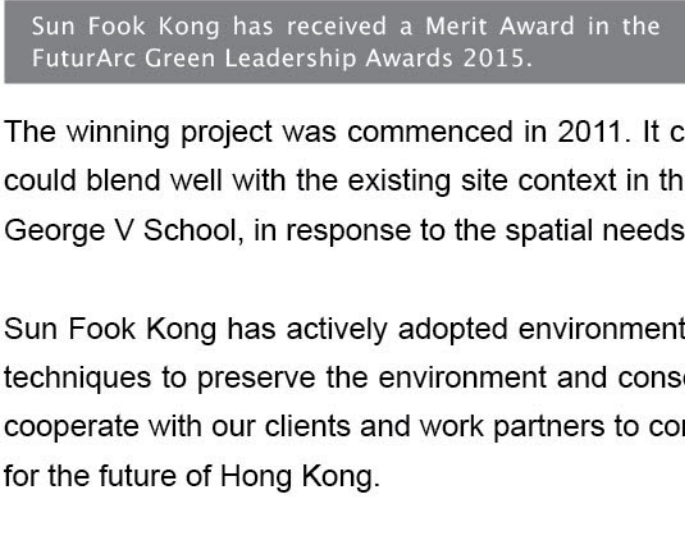


Sun Fook Kong is Honored in the FuturArc Green Leadership Awards 2015

FuturArc Green Leadership Award 2015 which is organized by FuturArc Journal, is a competition among the foremost Green building design in Asia. The aim of the competition is to recognize the team behind a completed project: the developer, consultants and contractors, who have collectively pushed the limits and definition of what a Green building is and have demonstrated the best in innovation and environmental stewardship in architecture. The panel of jury comprises of professors and leaders in the architecture and construction practice in India, Malaysia, Singapore, Australia and Hong Kong.

The winning project was commenced in 2011. It comprised the construction of a Performing Arts Block which could blend well with the existing site context in the campus of one of the oldest schools in Hong Kong – King George V School, in response to the spatial needs for expansion of campus facilities.

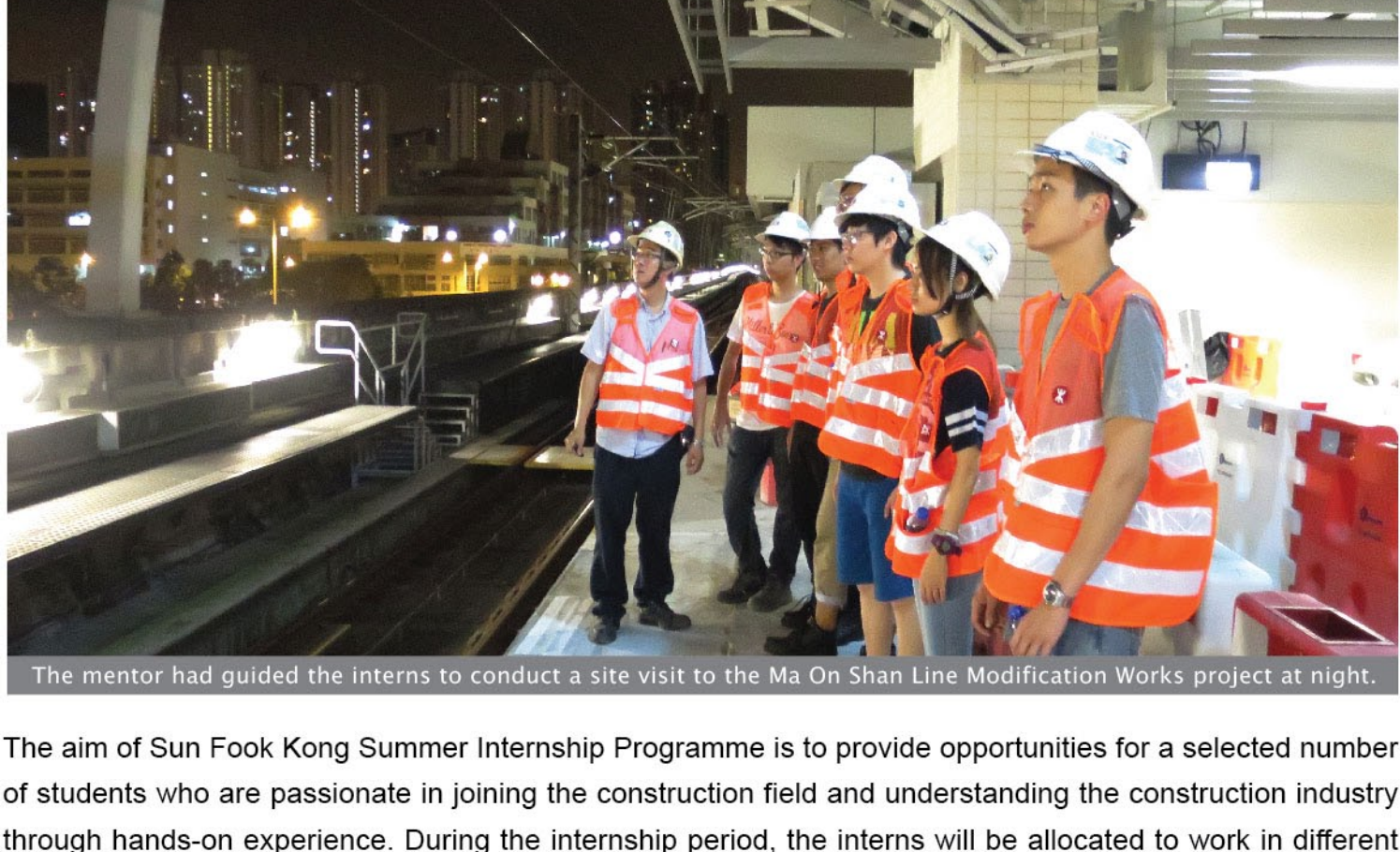

The mentor had guided the interns to conduct a site visit to the Ma On Shan Line Modification Works project at night.

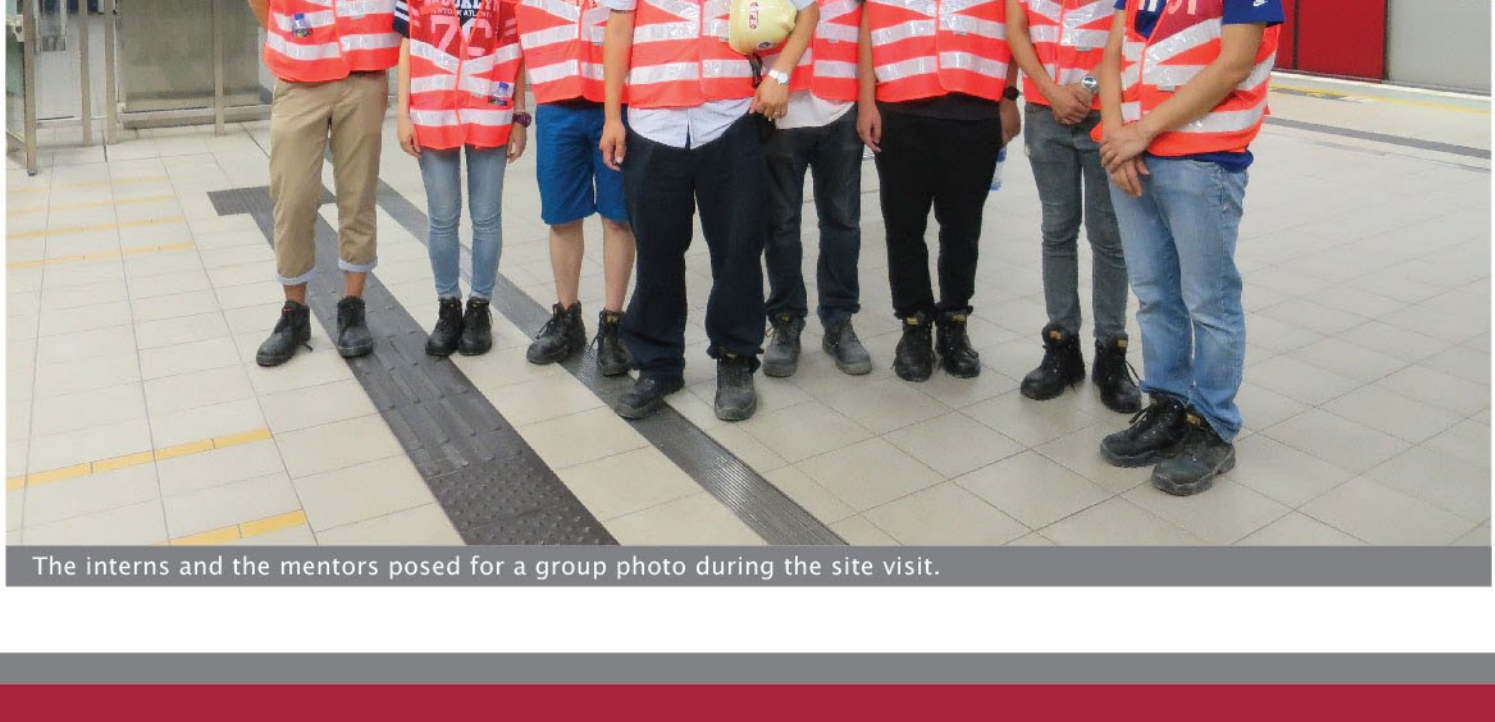
The aim of Sun Fook Kong Summer Internship Programme is to provide opportunities for a selected number of students who are passionate in joining the construction field and understanding the construction industry through hands-on experience. During the internship period, the interns will be allocated to work in different departments or site offices. Mentors will be assigned to them to provide guidance and share their experiences.

This year, the Company has arranged the interns to visit three construction sites in Ma On Shan Line Modification Works project at night. During the site visit, they are able to observe different trade works, the isolation of track side overhead cable and the installation of automatic platform gate. Ms. Samantha So, a Surveying student and Mr. Brown Leung, an Architecture student of The City University of Hong Kong both claimed that, "The site visit has deepened our understanding on the site environment and helped us better deal with our current work. Moreover, it inspires to our future career development."

The Programme has provided the interns with solid work experience. Mr. Roy Tang, a final year Civil Engineering student of The Polytechnic University in Hong Kong, said that, "It provides me a great chance to integrate my knowledge into the daily work, as well as to understand more deeply the different work procedures." Mr. Leo Leung, who is studying at the same faculty and in the same school as Mr. Roy Tang, also expressed that, "The Programme has enhanced my Civil Engineering knowledge and enabled me to see the whole picture of the construction industry and project operation."

All interns would like to thank the mentors for their guidance during the past two months. It is the second year for Mr. Woody Tse, a final year Mechanical Engineering student at the University of Leicester, mentioned that, "Under the guidance of my mentor, I have a chance to work in different positions, which allow me to gain knowledge about safety, environmental protection and building services, as well as to look into different construction stages."

In future, Sun Fook Kong will continue to organize the Summer Internship Programme, in order to nurture the future generation and to attract more young people to join the construction industry.

Currently, there are around 5000 solitary elderly living in Shun Shui Po District, whose social network is very weak. In June, over 400 Sun Fook Kong volunteers organized into teams to visit their home and to deliver the festive gifts to them, with a will to understand their needs and to help them feel being closely connected to the community.

In the meantime, the project team of "Shatin to Central Link contract no. 1101- Ma On Shan Line Modification Works" jointly organized a Dragon Boat Festival Visit to the Yan Chai Hospital Li Chan Yuk Sim Elderly Home with the MTR Corporation. The volunteers had led the elderly to do simple exercise, played mini games and distributed festival foods to them. Most of them were delighted to participate in the activity. This activity also provided a chance for the elderly to learn more about the "Shatin to Central Link Project", and helped the project team collect elderly's opinions towards the modification works.
