

Sun Fook Kong Participates in the Standard Chartered (HK) Marathon 2012

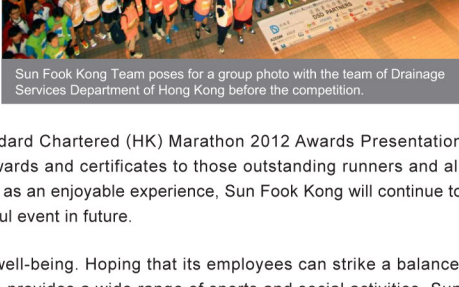

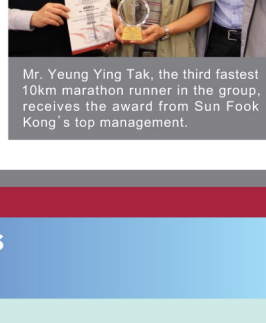

Mr. Lam Chun Yin, the fastest 10km marathon runner in the group, receives the award from Sun Fook Kong's top management.



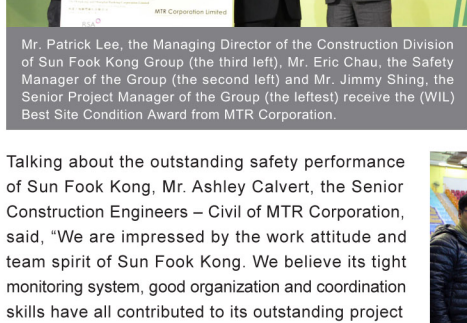
Mr. Yip Yiu Sing, the second fastest 10km marathon runner in the group, receives the award from Sun Fook Kong's top management.

Meanwhile, the MTR Corporation has presented the Best Site Condition Award to Sun Fook Kong and the Contractor's Supervisor Safety Award to Mr. Lee Tun Siu, the General Foreman of the Group.

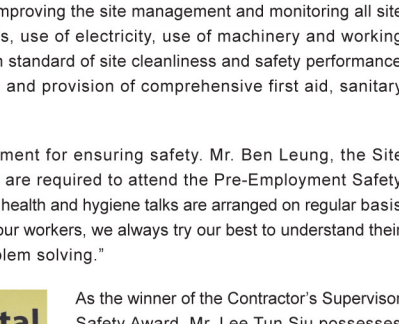

Talking about the outstanding safety performance of Sun Fook Kong, Mr. Ashley Calvert, the Senior Construction Engineers - Civil of MTR Corporation, said, "We are impressed by the work attitude and team spirit of Sun Fook Kong. and work closely together, so that all safety aspects can be well managed." Mr. Alex Ng, the Senior Safety Officer of Sun Fook Kong also said, "We keep improving the site management and monitoring all site activities including handling and storage of materials, use of electricity, use of machinery and working condition of tools. Sun Fook Kong always ensures high standard of site cleanliness and safety performance through implementation of fire preventive measures and provision of comprehensive first aid, sanitary and welfare facilities."

Besides, effective training is another important element for ensuring safety. Mr. Ben Leung, the Site Orientation Officer of Sun Fook Kong said, "All workers are required to attend the Pre-Employment Safety Orientation Course. On top of this, other safety trainings, health and hygiene talks are arranged on regular basis to uphold their safety knowledge. To enhance caring of our workers, we always try our best to understand their difficulties in work and give them full support in problem solving."



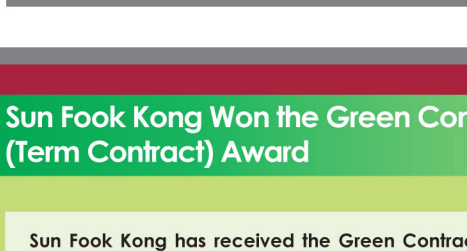
Mr. Lee Tun Siu, the General Foreman of Sun Fook Kong receives the Contractor's Supervisor Safety Award from MTR Corporation.

As the winner of the Contractor's Supervisor Safety Award, Mr. Lee Tun Siu possesses over 20 years' experiences in the construction industry. His daily works involves scheduling of work and monitoring of delivery of materials to job sites, supervision and arrangement of site labours. Based on his experience in safety management, Mr. Lee said, "We are highly aware of all potential high risks including fall of person and falling object. To enhance the safety awareness of workers, we keep reminding them to work in a safe and proper way." Moreover, Mr. Lee understands the importance of maintaining a cooperative relationship with our customer and he

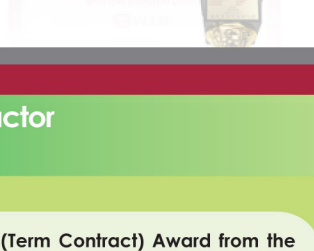
has frequently collected opinions from the MTR Project Team and the station workers. On the other hands, he would inform the related parties immediately when there is any potential risk found on site.

Sun Fook Kong commenced the "MTR West Island Line Contract No. 701 - Modification of Sheung Wan Station" in April, 2010. The scope of the work includes modification of customer service centre, provision of new passenger lifts and improvement works to the station facilities. In addition to the attainment of the Best Site Condition Award and Contractor's Supervisor Safety Award, Sun Fook Kong had won the Gold Environmental Award, Silver Safety Award and Lowest Reportable Accident Frequency Rate Award in the earlier period of 2011.

As a responsible contractor, Sun Fook Kong has been emphasizing safety and environmental protection, so that high project performance and quality can be achieved.

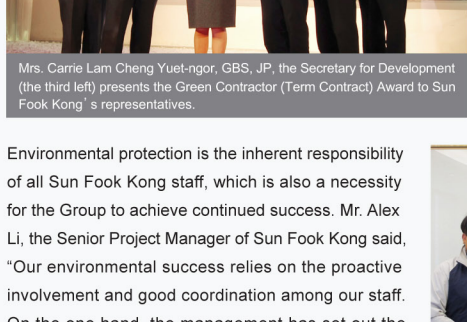

Sun Fook Kong Won the Green Contractor (Term Contract) Award

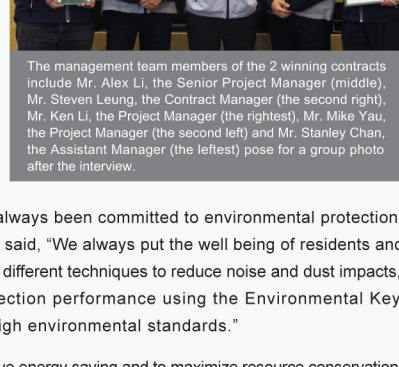
Sun Fook Kong has received the Green Contractor (Term Contract) Award from the Architectural Services Department (ArchSD) in recognition of its outstanding environmental performance. The two Maintenance Term Contracts, one for Hong Kong Island Western, Southern and Lantau Island, and the other for Tuen Mun and Yuen Long, both commenced in April, 2010. The scope of the work includes alterations, additions and condition survey, maintenance and repair services to the government properties and local facilities for which the ArchSD are responsible.

Since 2001, ArchSD has been organized the Green Contractor Award to encourage the implementation of good environmental practices and higher environmental standards in construction sites. All ArchSD projects which are under construction within the year and with contract sums over \$21 millions will be automatically participated in the competition. The winners were selected by the assessment board based on their performance on air pollution control, noise control, wastewater pollution control, waste management and tree protection etc.

Environmental protection is the inherent responsibility of all Sun Fook Kong staff, which is also a necessity for the Group to achieve continued success. Mr. Alex Li, the Senior Project Manager of Sun Fook Kong said, "Our environmental success relies on the proactive involvement and good coordination among our staff. On the one hand, the management has set out the environmental policy and objectives for the staff to follow and has closely monitored the execution of the respective environmental programs. On the other hand, the workers have given full support to the management on implementing the environmental protection measures in order to achieve good environmental performance."

Being a responsible contractor, Sun Fook Kong has always been committed to environmental protection. Mr. Steven Leung, the Contract Manager of the Group said, "We always put the well being of residents and pedestrians as first priority. In addition to the adoption of different techniques to reduce noise and dust impacts, we will periodically review our environmental protection performance using the Environmental Key Performance Indicators (EKPI), so as to maintain high environmental standards."

Moreover, Sun Fook Kong will adopt various ways to achieve energy saving and to maximize resource conservation. Mr. Ken Li, the Project Manager of the Group said, "Different energy saving products and systems have been applied in our projects, including the T5 fluorescent tubes, the LCD monitors in site office and the energy saving traffic lamps on sites." Furthermore, Sun Fook Kong has implemented on-site sorting of wastes according to the industry guideline, so that usable construction wastes can be segregated and be used as renewable resources. Mr. Mike Yau, the Project Manager of the Group said, "Environmental protection is not only one of the social corporate responsibilities, but also a long term investment for our Group. We believe our operating costs in the long run can be reduced through improvement in energy efficiency and waste management. A win-win situation for both the environment and the company can then be achieved."



Besides, the 2 projects have launched the "One Worker, One Plant" campaign to promote the "Green" message. Mr. Stanley Chan, the Assistant Project Manager of the Group said, "In order to enhance the environmental awareness among our workers and to improve air quality, we have given small plants to them and allocated a planting area in site office."

To maintain the outstanding environmental performance and to pursue sustainability, Sun Fook Kong will continually enhance its environmental management system, adopt innovative techniques and conform to the environmental protection standards.
