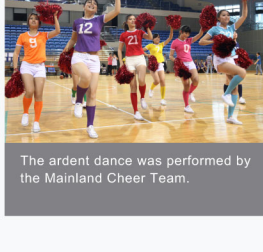

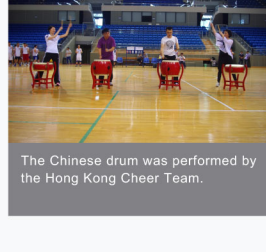

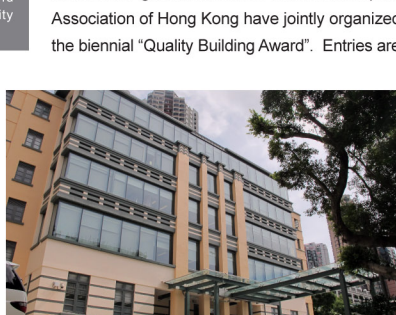

The MTR West Island Line Contract - "Re-provisioning of David Trench Rehabilitation Centre" commenced in July 2009. It lasted for 21 months and was completed in March, 2011 with the contract sum over HK\$300 million.
