

Fire Dragon Path in Tai Hang is Grand Opened Harbour Area Treatment Scheme Stage 2A - Topping Out Ceremony for the Main Pumping Station at Stonecutter Island Sewage Treatment Works

Drainage Services Department (DSD), Ove Arup & Partners Hong Kong Limited (Arup) and Sun Fook Kong-Joint Venture jointly held a topping out ceremony for the "Main Pumping Station at Stonecutter Island Sewage Treatment Works" on 19 June 2014. The ceremony was officiated by Mr. Chung Kum Wah, Daniel, JP, Director of Drainage Services of DSD, Mr. Chan Pak Keung, Assistant Director of Sewage Services of DSD, Mr. Siu Ka Kam, Norman, Assistant Director of Electrical & Mechanical of DSD, Mr. Jeremy Mark Sparrow, Chief Resident Engineer of Arup, Mr. Fergal Whyte, Director of Arup, Mr. Patrick Lee and Mr. John Ma, Directors of Sun Fook Kong-Biwater Joint Venture.

The new pumping station with an internal diameter of 55 metre and depth of 40 metre, which is a core facility of HATS 2A that lifts sewage from the deep tunnels to the ground surface at Stonecutters Island for chemically enhanced primary treatment, and the sewage will undergo disinfection before discharging to the western side of the Victoria Harbour. The MPS2 also provides a home for the new control system which integrates the existing treatment facilities under HATS 1 with the new facilities constructed under HATS 2A into a central control system.

The project team aims to achieve a low accident rate in this confined space work, Mr. Patrick Lee, the Director of Sun Fook Kong-Biwater Joint Venture said during his speech, "In order to achieve high quality and high efficiency, we take care every item in the construction procedure and have established a comprehensive safety monitoring system and actively promoted occupational safety and health among workers."

Although the project team had encountered some challenges during the construction process, they successfully completed to build this new pumping station through good communication, coordination and collaboration with all work partners. In future, Sun Fook Kong-Biwater will continue to strive for safety and high quality in all its projects.
