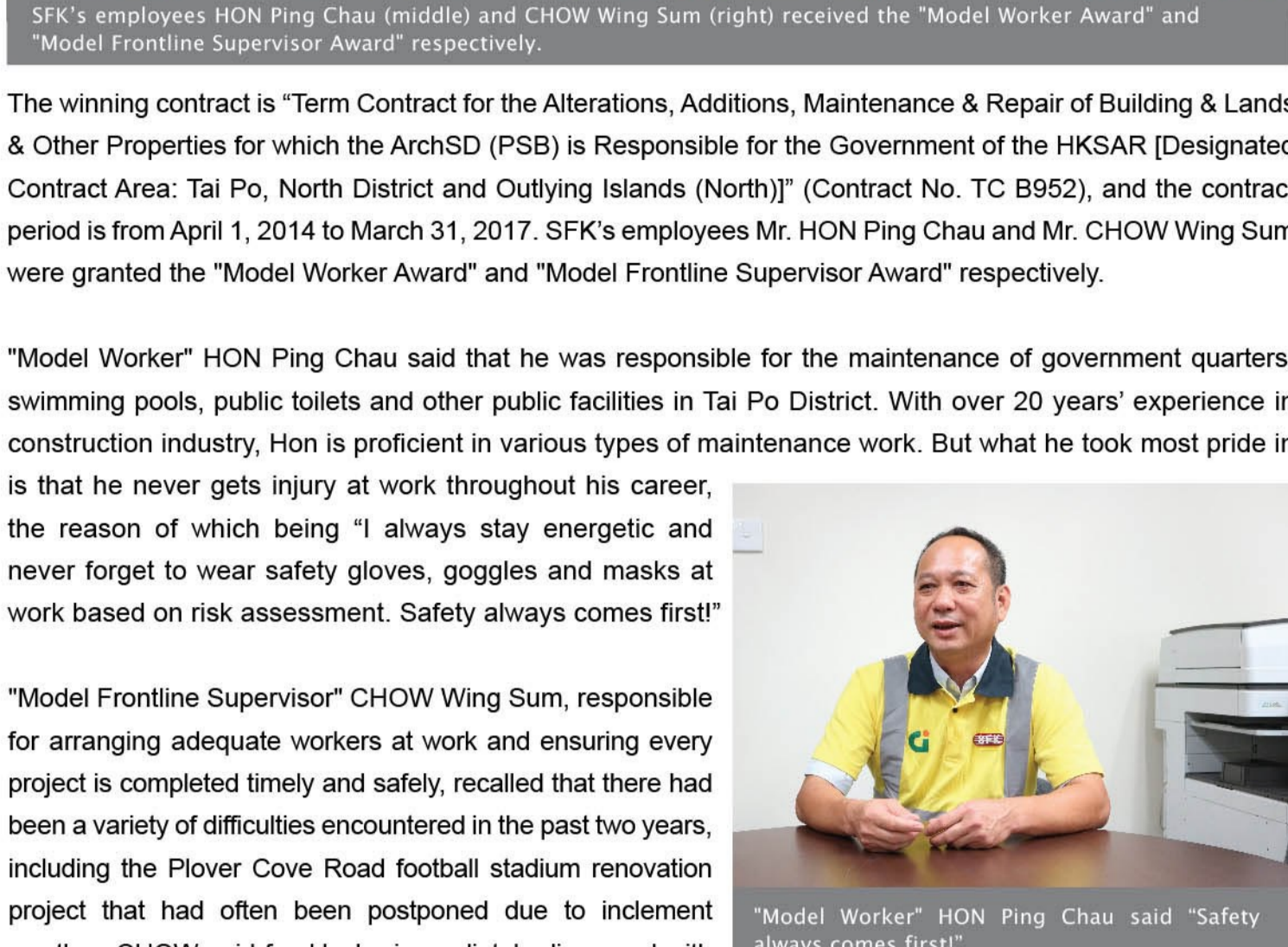


Sun Fook Kong was Granted "22nd Considerate Contractors Site Award Scheme" Merit Award

Jointly organized by Development Bureau and Construction Industry Council, the award ceremony of "22nd Considerate Contractors Site Award Scheme" was held on 27 May 2016 in Kowloon International Trade and Exhibition Centre. A term contract undertaken by Sun Fook Kong was granted "Considerate Contractors Site Award (Public Work - Repair, Maintenance, Alteration and Addition Works)" Merit Award, crediting Sun Fook Kong's excellent performance in occupational safety and environmental protection.

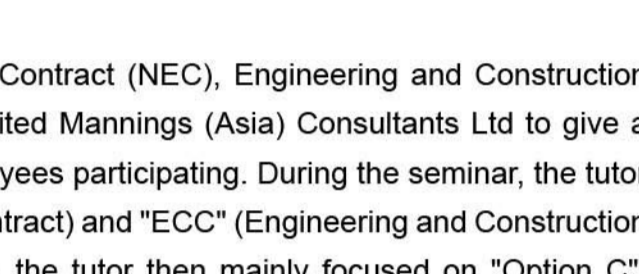
The winning contract is "Term Contract for the Alterations, Additions, Maintenance & Repair of Building & Lands & Other Properties for which the ArchSD (PSB) is Responsible for the Government of the HKSAR [Designated Contract Area: Tai Po, North District and Outlying Islands (North)]" (Contract No. TC B952), and the contract period is from April 1, 2014 to March 31, 2017. SFK's employees Mr. HON Ping Chau and Mr. CHOW Wing Sum were granted the "Model Worker Award" and "Model Frontline Supervisor Award" respectively.

"Model Worker" HON Ping Chau said that he was responsible for the maintenance of government quarters, swimming pools, public toilets and other public facilities in Tai Po District. With over 20 years' experience in construction industry, Hon is proficient in various types of maintenance work. But what he took most pride in is that he never gets injury at work throughout his career, the reason of which being "I always stay energetic and never forget to wear safety gloves, goggles and masks at work based on risk assessment. Safety always comes first!"

"Model Frontline Supervisor" CHOW Wing Sum, responsible for arranging adequate workers at work and ensuring every project is completed timely and safely, recalled that there had been a variety of difficulties encountered in the past two years, including the Plover Cove Road football stadium renovation project that had often been postponed due to inclement weather. CHOW said frankly, he immediately discussed with Leisure and Cultural Services Department at that time and revised the schedule. Furthermore, as the site supervisor, CHOW said one of his most important tasks was to unite workers, such as caring for their health, reminding them not to work too hard at extreme hot weather.

Sun Fook Kong Staff Training 2016

In order to improve the staff's expertise, Sun Fook Kong organized two training events in April and May 2016, "Site Visit to an International Theme Park Expansion Project" and "Training Seminar on New Engineering Contract (NEC), Engineering and Construction Contract (ECC) and Option C" respectively. 86 employees participated in these two events in total and most of them said they had learned a lot from the training.

"Site Visit to an International Theme Park Expansion Project" was held on 30 April, attracting 46 employees to participate. After listening to the presentation of the expansion project, all the participants directly visited the site of this project, and got the chance to inspect the structural work, external hard landscape, internal mechanical and electrical work and fitting-out work.

On the other hand, "Training Seminar on New Engineering Contract (NEC), Engineering and Construction Contract (ECC) and Option C" was held on 11 May, and invited Mannings (Asia) Consultants Ltd to give a lecture on newly adopted engineering contract, with 40 employees participating. During the seminar, the tutor firstly introduced the concepts of "NEC" (New Engineering Contract) and "ECC" (Engineering and Construction Contract). As "NEC" included six different options generally, the tutor then mainly focused on "Option C", namely "Term Contract with activity schedule". This seminar gave participants a valuable lesson and ended with a Q&A session, in which the confusions were solved and made the knowledge further understood.

Sun Fook Kong regards its staff as the most important asset and strives to provide sufficient trainings for them, including various kinds of site visits and seminars. Nurturing employees is a crucial responsibility. Sun Fook Kong will provide more opportunities to develop more talents in the future.

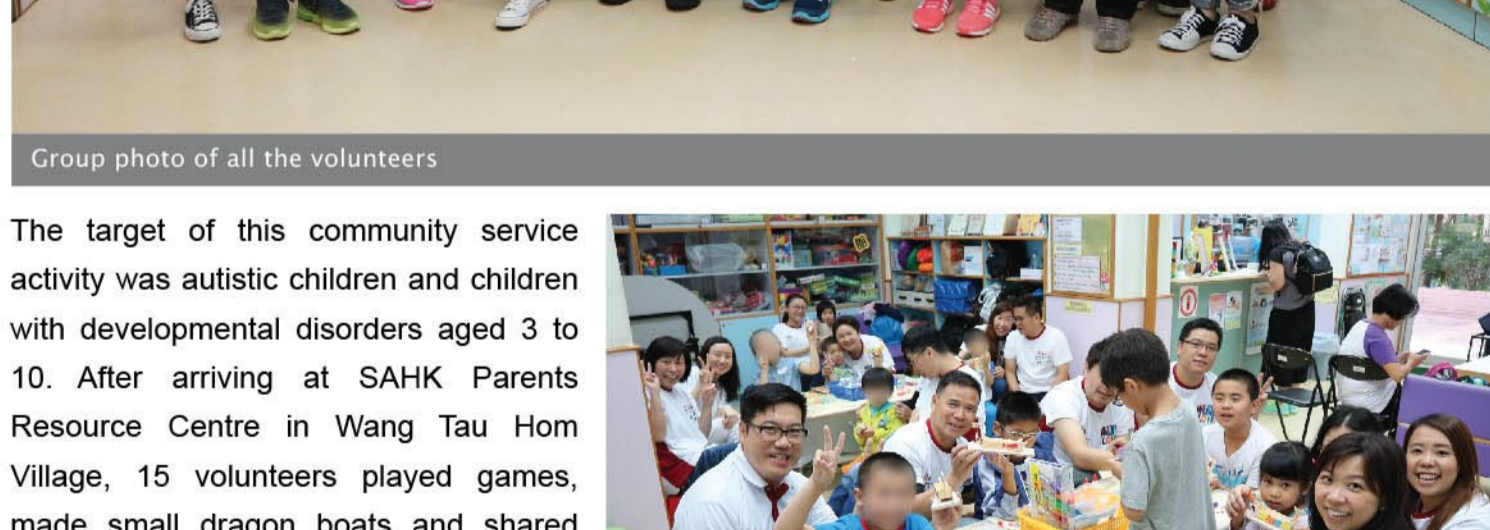

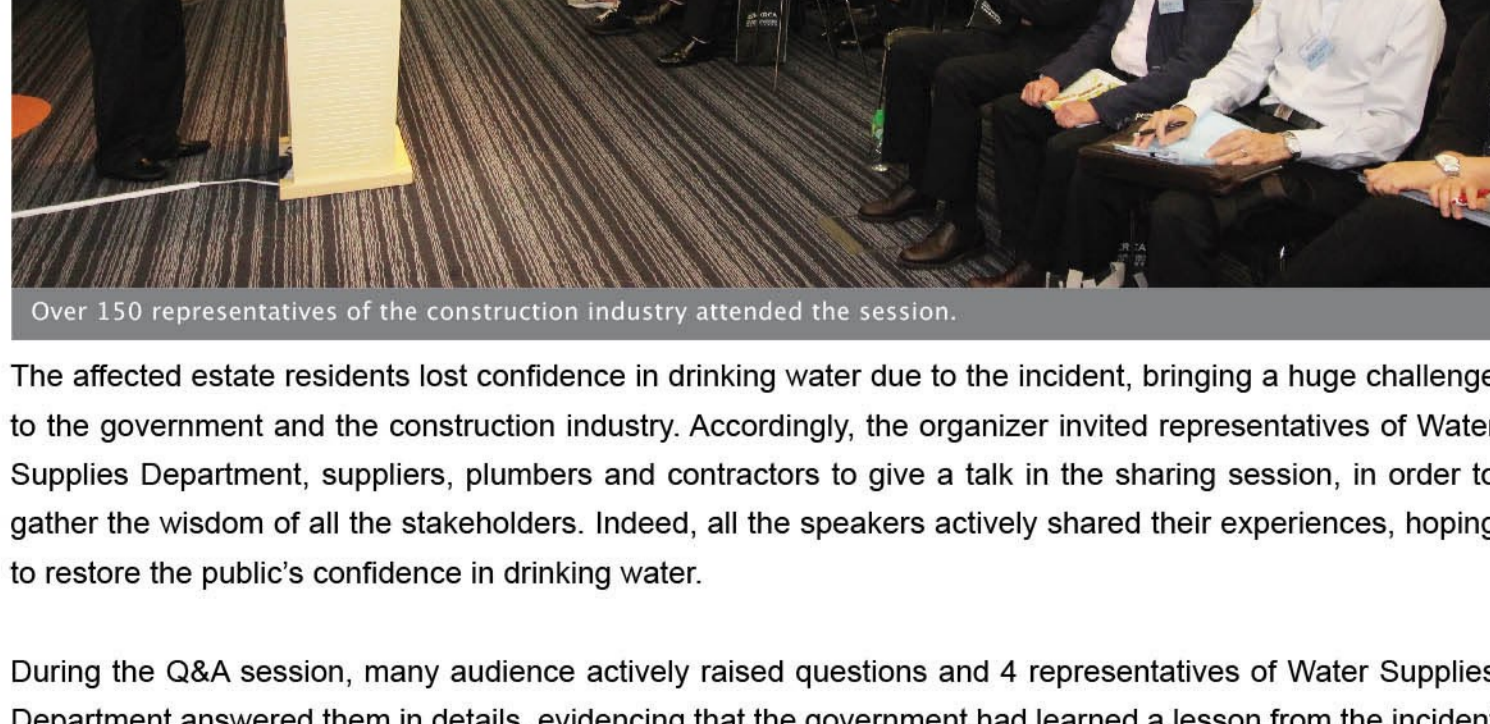

On 21 June 2016, Sun Fook Kong assisted the construction industry in organizing a sharing session on the incident of lead in drinking water. The sharing session was held by the Hong Kong Registered Contractors Association, and supported by Water Supplies Department, Hong Kong Licensed Plumbing Professional Association Limited, Shun Lee Bldg. Materials Limited, Bun Kee (International) Limited, Wong Po Kee Limited and Kam Tat Project Management Co. Over 150 representatives of the construction industry attended the session.

Indeed, all the speakers actively shared their experiences, helping to restore the public's confidence in drinking water.

During the Q&A session, many audience actively raised questions and 4 representatives of Water Supplies Department answered them in details, evidencing that the government had learned a lesson from the incident and determined to solve problems and improve the system in the long run.

Mr. Anthony Chan, President of the Hong Kong Registered Contractors Association, gave a speech to thank all the participants and hoped they would continue to give advices and suggestions for the challenges in the future.
